Summary of the project and workshop:

Overall Project Objective is to improve the functioning of electricity and gas markets in line with EU requirements.

Project Purpose is to improve the capacity of EMRA by the development of a new performance-based tariff calculation mechanism, including a social tariff.

The project aims at three main **results**:

1. Methodology for performance-based tariff calculation is developed.
2. Energy market monitoring system of EMRA is improved.
3. EMRA's capacity to regulate market through the use of performance-based tariffs is enhanced.

This workshop is the fourth activity under Task 1 – Improvement of performance-based tariff setting for transmission and distribution system operations. The purpose of the workshop is to present the draft results of two main activities:

1.1 Delivering Tariff Structure Assessment and Recommendations Report for both electricity and natural gas sectors

1.2 Delivering Data Requirements and Harmonization and Standardization of Data Report

During the workshop, information will be provided on the identified gaps between the Turkish tariff structure and the EU benchmarks and proposals will be presented on new and improved tariff structures. Finally, recommendation will be made to implement the proposed tariff structure, including legislative changes, data requirements and data harmonization procedures.

There will be audio-based Turkish-English simultaneous interpretation available during the workshop.

Participants from EMRA, MENR, BOTAS, TEIAS, etc. are herewith invited to attend this workshop and to benefit from the ongoing work in the Tariff project for EMRA.
